

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS: TENURE TRACK FACULTY POSITION IN PHYSICS

The Department of Science of the Pontificia Universidad Catolica del Peru (PUCP), invites applications for a tenure-track faculty position in the Physics. Applicants must hold a Ph.D. in physics or related fields in the areas of Astronomy and Astrophysics, Applied Optics, Quantum Optics, Non-Linear Dynamics, or Plasma Physics.

Application Deadline: Friday, August 30, 2024

The successful candidate will serve as a faculty member with a commitment of forty (40) hours per week, that includes research, teaching, and academic-administrative tasks (e.g., thesis committees, commissions).

Requirements:

- A Ph.D. in Physics.
- Postdoctoral experience.
- A strong publication record in indexed journals Q1 and Q2 (Web of Science and Scopus).
- Presentations at peer-reviewed international academic conferences in the last three years.

Commitments for the 3-year Contract Period:

1. Research Commitments:

- Publications in indexed journals (Scopus or Web of Science Q1/Q2), with a minimum of four publications showing PUCP affiliation.
- Participation in at least one international scientific conference per year.
- Participation and collaboration with current researchs groups.

2. Teaching Commitments:

• Teach 10 lecture hours per year, with at least 3 at the undergraduate level across undergraduate and/or graduate courses.



- Supervise undergraduate and/or graduate theses.
- High scores in students evaluations.

3. Other Commitments:

- Affiliation: Must indicate PUCP affiliation in all publications and presentations.
- Exclusivity: Teach only at PUCP, except as a guest lecturer or visiting researcher.

- 4. Research Statement (maximum three pages) including:
 - Summary of research, highlighting the most representative works
 - Future research projects at the university if selected
 - Synergy with research areas at Physics Section, with emphasis in application
 - Academic contacts that could lead to collaborative projects
- 5. Teaching Statement (maximum 3 pages) including:
 - University teaching experience, if any.
 - Vision of research transfer in teaching.
 - Courses or subjects related to the discipline you would like to teach at university
 - Describe undergraduate and graduate thesis counseling experience, if any.
- 6. Two letters of recommendation attesting your relevant experience and character.

The CV and required documents must be submitted in a single PDF file.

PUCP promotes gender equality in academia. Female candidates are encouraged to apply.



Evaluation Process:

The evaluation will be conducted by a five-member jury, including three professors from the Department of Sciences (two from the area and one from another area) and two external evaluators from prestigious international universities. The evaluation process will

- 1. Review of submitted documents.
- 2. Evaluate the teaching and research competencies with two consecutive seminars: a research presentation, and an assessment of academic capabilities. Sessions may be conducted remotely.
- 3. Conduct a professional psychological assessment before a job offer.
